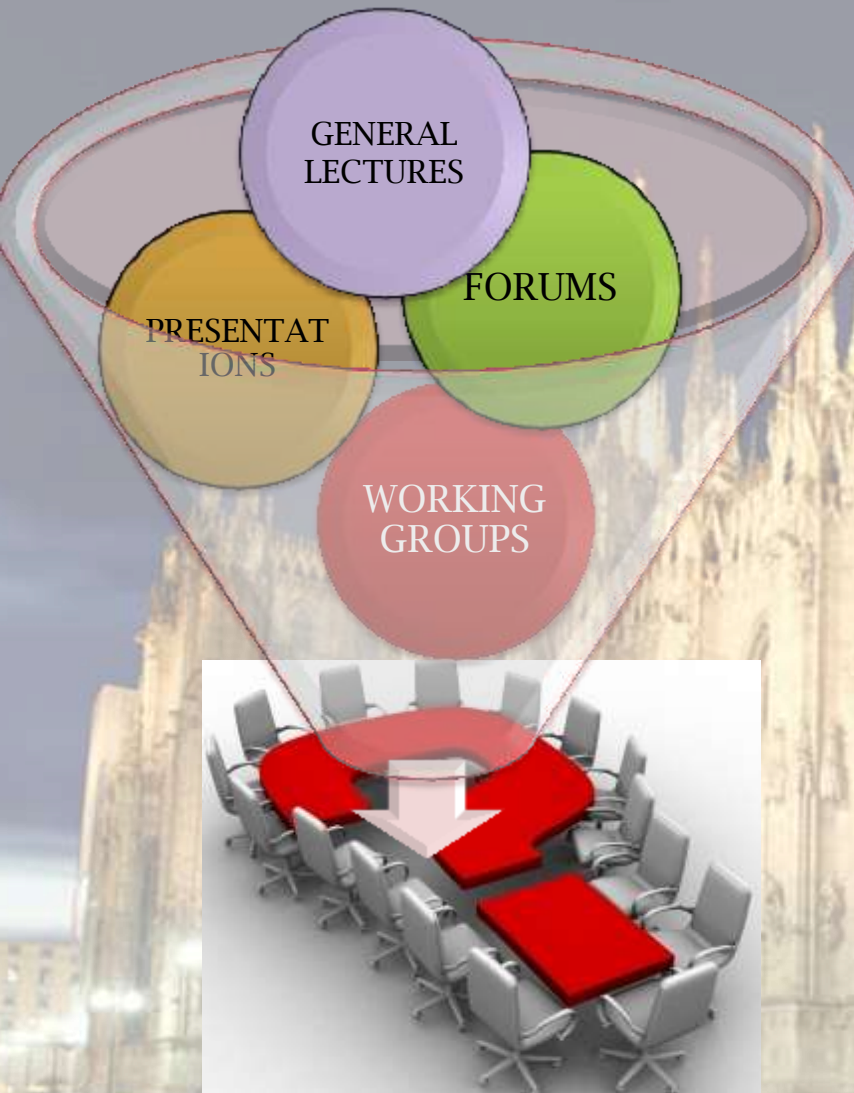


# Conference Structure
